- We need to explicitly say on the website when people are registering their children that the House-league in girls' hockey is not a traditional house-league. The house league in girls' hockey is a level, and not a pay-to-play structure.
- There will be enough skaters again to field three U9 teams. Hopefully this year we will be better able to split them into teams based on their skating levels.

Sarnia Silver Stick Tournament

- Dave Schrie, Tournament Director announced that the Silver Stick Tournament would be Thursday January 2nd to Sunday January 5th, 2025.
- The date will be rotating yearly, in order to avoid the ice/hotel problem that happened last year when there were three local tournaments all the same weekend.
- The fee will be increasing to \$1500 (from \$1300)
- Silver Stick would like to include a U9 age division this year.

Goalie Incentives

- In order to attract goalies to the organization, SJLS has decided to add a new fee structure, giving full time goalies 50% off their registration fees for the coming year.
- This is to follow suit with other organizations who are paying the full registration fee for players committing to net.

Registration Fees:

- The registration fee structure is yet to be determined.
- There will be a discount code to get \$75 off your registration (the \$75 from the Tryouts)
- And a discount code of 50% for goal tenders.
- Fees are increasing for ice time, and for referees. Bluewater Referees are now changing travel costs to their fees.
- Other centres around have increased their fees to \$1100 from \$800 due to these drastic increases in costs.
