 - Tryout debrief: Overall the coaches provided feedback about the tryouts. Thank you

Nathan Jeffrey (Compliance)

- o Transition from Brent to Nathan for compliance is going well.
- Nathan has created a media release for the Hayley Wickenheiser event this Thursday.
 He will also create another, more general media release that teams will be able to use in the future.

Kyle Doyle (Development)

- Kyle has 450 drills on a USB stick to assist coaching staff. He has divided the drills into three parts; fundamentals, tactical skills, and physical conditioning.
- Discussion about CoachThem, an online coaching tool. Kyle will register for CoachThem
 for the upcoming year. Once he and Nathan Jeffrey have determined whether it would
 be a good fit for the organizing we will look into getting an organizational login so all
 coaching staff can access the drills in one centralized location.
- Does not want teams using their development funds paying for camps that not all the players are able to attend. All players should benefit from the development funds.
- Kyle would like to see player assessments in the coming year. Would like to see goal setting done for each player, with measurable and evaluation to provide empirical data on player improvement

Todd Pepper (Equipment)
